

The spring meeting of the Clemons Pond Association was held on May 24, 1987 at Norman and Marion Brown's. Pres. Charles Saurman opened the meeting at 10:30 with 13 members present, which did not consist a quorum. The Secretary's report was accepted as read and the Treasurer's report showed a balance of \$511.64 and \$116.16 in the Road Fund also accepted as read. Jeannette Ward reported the new sign at Notch Rd. had been vandalized and that Judy Comer and Carol Hill had taken the name signs in for the winter and repaired them and then re-hung them. A motion was made and seconded that they submit a bill for their expense for repairs.

A discussion followed about the condition of the lot with a camper on Notch Rd., and Victor Zelman reported the town Planning Board and Selectmen had engaged a lawyer with an injunction proceeding to have possessions removed by May 15. The president expressed appreciation for his efforts. The condition of Notch Rd. was discussed, but further action was tabled until the fall. As taxpayers any individual could attend a Selectmen's meeting to complain about the problem. A motion was made and seconded to send a plant or dish garden to Carol Hill who is in a hospital in Portland. Jeannette volunteered to order one. The annual picnic was discussed and it was decided we follow the same procedure as last year with the same refreshment Committee: Flo Whiting, Marion Brown, Jeannette Ward and Ava Saurman. The date was set for July 18 at 12:00 tentively at the Morses.

Jeannette suggested the Association buy dragonflies for mosquito control. Norm Brown made a motion seconded by Lyndon Ward, that Moe Rousseau investigate the feasibility of ordering dragonflies to be planted around the pond this year. The money would be allocated at the next meeting, subject to approval, because of lack of a quorum at this meeting. Marion reported that Gertrude Meggison is now a year-round resident on the pond. Victor suggested developing a modified crime watch to be aware of suspicious activity in the area, but no action was taken on this matter. At 12:00 the meeting was adjourned.
