

The Clemons Pond Association fall meeting was held on Sept. 4, at the Rousseau cottage. President Charles Saurman opened the meeting at 10:10 with 28 members present. The Secretary's report was accepted as read. The Treasurer reported the cost of the picnic was \$53.18, and the report was approved.

Marlene Livonia reported she had pamphlets on pressure-treated wood for distribution. It was reported that the Fire Department is looking for an acceptable location in the pond area for a fire hydrant. Carolyn Rousseau will report at the next meeting on their progress. Also, it was voted that the Association offer a list of names and locations of cottages to assist them.

A report of the picnic was given to the Secretary as reference for future picnics. The picnic committee was thanked for their work and given a round of applause. Carol Hill made a motion that the picnic be hold at the same time each year, the third Saturday of July at 12:00, and Moe Rousseau seconded the motion.

Ken Osgood reported he had made algae tests in the pond during the summer and that it was clear for 16-18 feet which was very good. The deepest area of the pond is 44 feet. Frequent pumping of septic tanks was advised and Marlene reported that Jerry Anderson would pump for \$45 if several owners wanted it done at the same time. Ralph Morse suggested it be done in the spring. Judy Comer presented a slate of officers for the Nominating Committee: Pres.-Moe Rousseau, Vice Pres.-Dave Dilley, Treas.-Louise Novak, and Sec.-Delores Levesque. A motion was made and seconded the Secretary cast one ballot. Bob Barber suggested we should try to get street lights installed, and as many as could attend the next meeting of the Selectmen.* Victor Zelman offered to speak to them on this matter. The spring meeting will be held at the Saurman cottage, on the Sunday before Memorial Day. The President appointed May Hazen official Historian. The subject of honorary members was discussed, but it was decided it would not be feasible. The meeting was adjourned at 11:15.
